Alice and I left Africa 20 years ago. Then we began working in a number of Chinese churches in the San Jose, CA area. Today, the **Chinese Church in Christ (CCiC)** has really grown and has planted churches in six other strategic locations. There are multiple congregations speaking Mandarin, Cantonese, and English, with a combined attendance of about 2,000.

They have reached out to new immigrants coming to the U.S. Those coming from China have been among the most receptive to the gospel. As some of them return to China, pray with us for their continued growth and witness.

Young couples have also responded to full-time overseas missionary service in **Central Asia, China, Taiwan, Indonesia, the Sudan, South Africa, Latin America, and Europe**. And a good number have entered seminary preparing to serve churches here in **America**.

For many the path of obedience to God's calling has not been easy. But we thank God for each one and pray He will protect and use them for His glory.

We share this good news with you, so that you can rejoice with us that the gospel is spreading from **Jerusalem... to the uttermost parts** (Acts 1:8) through Chinese believers.
