## If a Man Dies Will He Live Again?

Job 14:1-6; 19:25-27

Does anyone recognize the name “Mel Blanc?” He was the voice behind all of the cartoon characters in *Looney Tunes*. At the end of every movie, you would see Porky Pig come on the screen, and he would always say the same thing: **“That’s all folks!”**

A couple of years ago, Mel Blanc died. Do you know what his family put on his gravestone? “That’s all folks.”

This is the question on Easter Sunday: Which is true?

**He is risen** indeed,  
**Or**  
That’s all folks?

Does death mean that the show is over, or is it possible that somewhere the real show is just starting? Let's look at this by walking through a passage in the Bible.

### *Lessons*

#### I. DEATH MAKES US ALL EQUAL (14:1-6)

- A. We are \_\_\_\_\_ (vv 1-2) “Man is of few days and full of trouble.”
- B. We are under \_\_\_\_\_ (vv 3-4) “Who can bring what is pure from the impure? No one!”
