THE MAKING OF A KING DEVOTIONAL PLAN

Read along with us through 1 & 2 Chronicles and the book of Matthew as we learn of The Lord's faithfulness to his covenant with David, to protect his lineage—the lineage of Jesus—in the midst of unrest, judgement, and repentance. HOW TO READ THIS DEVOTIONAL

STUDY: At the end of each day's reading, ask yourself the following questions:

How is the character of God's displayed in this chapter?

How does this chapter allude to Christ?

Where in this chapter do we see God remaining faithful to his promises?

What can I learn through the lives of the people in this chapter?

PRAY: Begin all your prayers by praising God for who he is and how he has revealed his character to you in the reading.

SHARE: Include others in what God is teaching you through His word. Share with your family, friends, co-workers, and neighbors. Allow God to work through you for His glory.
